FLINT CHILDREN'S MUSEUM RECEIVED \$500 GRANT FOR FUNDRAISER EVENT

FLINT, MI – The Flint Children's Museum is the recipient of a \$500 grant from the Community Impact Fund of the Community Foundation of Greater Flint.

This grant was used to support the Flint Children's Museum's annual fundraiser event, *Are You Smarter than a Grade Schooler?* in October 2010. The funds received go directly to museum operational and programming expenses, allowing the museum to continue providing quality educational experiences and reduced admission costs for those in our community.

"This grant will assist the museum in developing exhibits and programs that make each visit to the museum a unique experience," said Margo Strebic, Communication/Marketing Director.

With the support of the Community Foundation of Greater Flint, the Flint Children's Museum was able to raise over \$18,000 through the fundraiser event.
