STUDENT ART EXHIBIT AT THE FLINT CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

FLINT, MI— Over 80 pieces of student artwork will be on exhibit at the Flint Children's Museum this March. Artists from artsJAM Flint and VSA arts of Michigan—Genesee County will display their work in the VSA Arts-Ecology Show beginning on Thursday, March 11 through Saturday, March 20.

VSA arts is an organization that promotes arts, education, and creative expression involving children and adults with disabilities. VSA arts programs take place in more than 50 countries around the world and throughout the United States.

The show's theme, Arts-Ecology, links the arts with science and nature. A variety of arts media have been used to create the works, including paper mache, acrylic paint, marker and crayon, and digital photography. The artwork on exhibit includes a mobile called "Critter Carousel", whimsical representations of animals in paper mache, and cyanotype negative fabric works.

The Arts-Ecology Reception for the exhibit will take place on Thursday, March 11 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The community is invited to view the art and enjoy refreshments and entertainment throughout the evening. Admission to the reception is free.

Regular museum admission of \$4/person is required to view the exhibit. The museum is located on the campus of Kettering University at 1602 W. University Avenue in Flint.
