FLINT CHILDREN'S MUSEUM RECEIVES \$3,000 GRANT FOR MONTHLY PROGRAMS

FLINT, MI - The Flint Children's Museum is the recipient of a \$3,000 grant from the Veit Youth Charitable Trust.

The grant will name Veit Youth Charitable Trust as the sponsor for the months of June, July and October. The funds will help to provide supplies for activities, guest visitors, and special programs. Support will also make it possible to offer one Dollar Day during each of the months, allowing everyone access to the museum's offerings, especially those who are less fortunate. Dollar Day admission is only \$1 per person.
